Clubhouse & Equipment

Our Clubhouse was fully refurbished in 2016 after we were awarded a generous grant from Sport England. We have 6 all-weather courts, 4 of which are floodlit. The use of the floodlights is included in your membership. The flood light switches are located on the side of the floor to ceiling cupboards. This cupboard also contains the keys to access the Courts, which are on large wooden fobs.

In addition to the Courts there is also a hitting wall on Courts 5 & 6 for individual practice. There is a ball machine available for use - once you have been shown how to use it. Tennis balls are stored in the rack by the changing rooms. After use they should be returned to the ball rack. There are a variety of adult & junior rackets available to borrow. Otherwise you can always bring your own. Taylor Tennis provide racket advice and a stringing service.



Club sessions

Monday Evenings from 6:30pm. Doubles matches are arranged for you and each match lasts 25 mins following which you join another arranged four. From early April until mid-July, it's used for match practice where the emphasis is on single sex team play rather than mixed doubles.

Tuesday mornings from 9am. Popular with off-peak members. If you are new to club play and can make this session then it is a good place to start. You will find everyone very welcoming.

Thursday Evenings from 6:30pm. Popular family BBQ social during the summer months.

Friday mornings from 9am. Popular with off-peak members.

Social Saturdays from 2pm-4:30pm.

Facilities

Please feel free to use the TV and wifi. The wifi code is on the notice board. Please make use of the excellent kitchen facilities. There is complimentary Tea & Coffee for members. As well as the changing rooms and shower we also have disabled access and baby changing facilities.
